### **Directions from the West (Cornwall)**

(From Liskeard, take the A390 to Callington, then the A388 to Launceston)

Take the A30 to Launceston from where take the A388 to Holsworthy. Just before entering Holsworthy, turn right onto the A3072 signed Hatherleigh and after about 4 miles turn left at the side of the Bickford Arms. This is signposted to Shebbear.

Stay on this road, our drive is 3½ miles from this turn. You will eventually go over 2 small bridges and pass a cottage on the left with a water wheel, at this point you are just under a mile from our turn.

As you approach our turn you will see a Z bend sign and then on the first bend, a white bungalow set high above the road on the left (you will only see the bungalow when you are actually on the bend). Our turn is on the right opposite this (the road bends to the left).

This is a blind bend, so you may wish to carry on round the bends, turn around and approach on the safer side of the road.

*Note: If you come to a fork in the road with a grass triangle and a yellow sign to Aish Park, you have gone about ½ mile too far.*

Our turn off is a rough farm track used by tractors, so please drive very slowly, avoiding the potholes as much as possible.

When you see 2 five bar gates ahead of you, follow the track round to the left. You will almost immediately be driving alongside a high cob wall which is our boundary. This leads onto some hedging and then turn to the right down our drive to a five bar gate. The gate is kept closed to keep our dogs in (we have 6 Irish Wolfhounds) – please close it after you. Come through the gate, park and go through the tunnel on the left of the house into our courtyard and main entrance.
